



PARENT FAQ's

- **WHAT IS STUDENT LIFE CAMP LIKE?**

Student Life Camp is a Christ-centered camp for 6th-12th graders. It includes engaging worship from experienced worship leaders, learning through sound biblical teaching and Bible study, community in Life Groups, and fun in recreation! It's a week of focused learning, heartfelt praise, games, dramas, community building, teamwork, and most importantly, God's Word on center stage.

- **WHAT KIND OF ADULT SUPERVISION IS PROVIDED?**

We will be taking trained adult volunteers, who are passionate about investing in your students' lives, to serve as small group and room leaders. All of our leaders will be equipped and coached, as well as cleared through a background check.

- **ARE THE MEALS PROVIDED?**

YES! Once we arrive at camp, we will eat all meals together in the buffet style cafeteria on the grounds of YMCA of the Rockies. Students only need to bring money to pay for 2 meals: Lunch on the way there, and lunch on the way back.

- **WHAT IF MY CHILD HAS FOOD ALLERGIES?**

Most allergies will not be a problem due to the wide variety of food selection at the camp, but if need be there is a plain grilled chicken breast and vegetables option available each meal as well.

- **HOW IS EVERYBODY GETTING TO CAMP?**

We have vans reserved to get our students to camp. We will fill as many vans as possible with students for this life-changing week.

- **WILL MY STUDENT BE ABLE TO TAKE A CELL PHONE?**

Yes. Students may take cell phones to Student Life Camp, but time will be limited on them. Cell phone time will be at the discretion of the group leader. During main sessions, organized rec time, and after lights out, cell phones must be out of sight. Students who abuse this freedom will have their phones taken up and given back at the end of camp. This week is about connecting them with Jesus and ignoring distractions. (We will provide a list of adult leader contacts available for you to call 24/7 if you were to need to reach your student.)

- **IS THERE A CAMP THEME?**

Student Life Camp 2018 will explore the characteristics of the one and only living God (Deuteronomy 6:4), as experienced by Moses and the Israelites throughout Exodus. Rather than reduce God to a single attribute, your students will encounter the complete nature of an indescribable Creator (Exodus 3:14) who, in His grace and holiness (Exodus 12) and through the gift of His Son, lavishes love to His people. (Exodus 19) He promises to be with them (Exodus 40:34-38) both now and forever. Unlike our current culture which suffers from intense “god” confusion, your students will have a clear picture of not only God’s character, but also how He relates to His children. They will return home with a firm theological and relational foundation to form a God-centered worldview and decision-making process.

- **WHO IS THE CAMP SPEAKER?**

The camp speaker for the week is Ben Trueblood. Ben is the Director of Student Ministries for Lifeway Christian Resources. He is a phenomenal communicator of the Word of God, and will challenge the students through God’s Word all week long.
